Day 4: Varna – Nesebar – Kazanlak (280 km)

Breakfast. Visit to the Assumption of the Virgin Mary cathedral and the archaeological museum in Varna. Travel along the Black Sea coast to Nessebar. Drive through the biggest seaside resort Sunny Beach. Enjoy a sightseeing tour of the old part of Nessebar, situated on a peninsula (historical and architectural reserve under the protection of UNESCO). Lunch. Depart for Kazanlak. Listen to a church chant. Accommodation. Dinner. Overnight stay.

Day 5: Kazanlak – Bachkovo - Plovdiv (160 km)

Breakfast. Visit to the factory laboratory producing cosmetics based on rose oil. Visit to the replica of a Thracian ruler's tomb, that can focus your attention on its architectural style and colourful frescoes (the original tomb is under the protection of UNESCO). Visit to the "Nativity" church , which stands for a temple erected in honour of the soldiers who died in the Russian-Turkish war for the freedom of Bulgaria. Depart for Assenovgrad. Lunch. Visit to the "St. Nicola" church. Visit to the Bachkovo monastery. Departure for Plovdiv. Accommodation. Dinner in a typical Bulgarian restaurant. Overnight stay.

Day 6: Plovdiv – Koprivshtitsa – Sofia (250 km)

Breakfast. Sightseeing: the architectural reserve "The Old Plovdiv", the "Sts. Constantine and Helena" church, the Roman amphitheatre and the ethnographic museum. Depart for Koprivshtitsa. Lunch. Take a walk along the picturesque and cobbled streets of the small town from the National Revival period. Sightseeing: authentic Bulgarian houses from the 19th century. Depart for Sofia. Accommodation. Dinner. Overnight stay.

Day 7: Sofia – Rila monastery – Sofia (250 km)

Breakfast. Visit to the Boyana church (under the protection of UNESCO), which realistic pictures are considered to be predecessor of the Renaissance in Europe Depart for Rila monastery (under the protection of UNESCO). Visit to this most remarkable monument of the Bulgarian architecture and culture from the National Revival period. Lunch. Depart for Sofia. A walk through the centre of Sofia with a visit to the "Alexander Nevski" cathedral. Accommodation at a hotel. Dinner in a traditional restaurant. Overnight stay.



Day 2: Sofia – Rila monastery – Melnik (220 km)

After breakfast – set off for Rila monastery-founded in X-th century. (under the protection of UNESCO). Sightseeing. Lunch. Departure for Melnik. Accommodation. Dinner. Overnight stay.

Day 3: Melnik – Rozhen Monastery – Plovdiv (220 km)

Breakfast. Explore Melnik and Kordupulov's house. Make for the Rozhen monastery. Sightseeing. Lunch on the way to Plovdiv. Arrival in Plovdiv. Accommodation. Dinner. Overnight stay.

Day 4: Plovdiv – Bachkovo Monastery – Arapovo Monastery – Plovdiv (70 km)

Breakfast. Set off for Arapovo monastery. Sightseeing. Lunch in Assenovgrad. Visit to the Bachkovo monastery founded in year 1083. Getting back to Plovdiv. Visiting the Old city. Dinner. Overnight stay.

Day 5: Plovdiv – Starossel – Kazanlak (140 km) After breakfast, make for Starossel. Visit to the archaeological complex. Lunch in Kazanlak. After lunch - visiting the Kazanlak tomb, the Russian church in Shipka. Church - Slavonic chant in Kazanlak. Dinner. Overnight stav.

Day 6: Kazanlak – Nessebar – Varna (300 km) After breakfast - departure for Nessebar. Lunch. Explore the old city. Departure for Varna. Dinner. Overnight stay.

Day 7: Varna – Aladzha monastery – Varna (40 km)

Breakfast. Visit to Aladzha monastery. Lunch. Visit to the archaeological museum and the Cathedral. Dinner and overnight stay.

Day 8: Varna - Shoumen - Veliko Tarnovo - Arbanasi (250 km)

After breakfast – departure for Shoumen. Visit to the functioning Tombul mosque. Lunch. Departure for Veliko Tarnovo. Sightseeing: the historical Tsarevets hill. Dinner and overnight stay in Arbanasi village.

Day 9: Arbanassi - Dryanovo monastery - Tryavna -

Kilifarevo monastery – Arbanasi (110 km) Breakfast. Departure for Dryanovo monastery. Sightseeing. Lunch in Tryavna. Visit to the Kilifarevo monastery. Gettung back to Arbanassi. Dinner and overnight stay.

Day 10: Arbanasi – Troyan (130 km)

Breakfast. Visit to Troyan monastery. Lunch. Departure for Troyan monastery. Accommodation. Dinner and overnight stay.

Day 11: Troyan – Sofia (150 km)

After breakfast - departure for Sofia. Lunch. Visit to the Boyana church and a wolk in the centre of the city - "St. George" church, the Presideney, the "Narodno Sabranie" square with the Bulgarian Parliament, the "Alexander Nevski" cathedral, the "st. Sofia" church, the antique market. Formal dinner with a folklore program. Overnicht stay.

Day 12: Sofia

Free time in the centre of the city. Lunch. Transferto the Sofia airport.







valley of the roses

Discover the well known Bulgarian old craft of rose distillation; pay interesting visits to the rose oil cosmetics centre, the folklore traditions and festivities; live music, songs and dances; intellectual and educational talks with Father Jordan in "St. Nicolas" church.

nessebar

They call it "The town of Melsa", "The pearl of Orthodoxy" and "The Bulgarian Ravenna". That is Nessebar - a small town on the Black Sea coast, which is a must to see. It is a small town, but with great history. A town, with its hundreds of monuments, that was included in 1983 in the List of the monuments of the World Cultural Heritage of UNESCO and has been carrying the fame of a world value with dignity for already 25 years.

Day I: Sofia Arrival in Sofia. Transfer to the hotel. Overnight stay.

Day 2: Sofia – Bachkovo – Plovdiv (180 km)

Travel to the second largest Bulgarian monastery - Bachkovo monastery. Lunch in Assenovgrad. Visit to the "St. Nicola" church. Getting back to Plovdiv. Enjoy a sightseeing the old part of the city - an architectural museum. Among the antique monuments, the most impressive are the ancient amphitheatre and the Roman stadium. Dinner. Overnight stay.

8 days

Day 3: Plovdiv - Karlovo – Plovdiv (160 km)

Early breakfast. Make for Karlovo. A stop in the rose fields near the city - rose - picking, folklore program live music, songs and dances, dedicated to the Queen of the flowers. Visit to the craftsman's centre, where a demonstration of rose oil manufacturing can be seen, as well as tasting jam and liquor of roses, and one can choose from hand-made souvenirs. Lunch. Get back to Plovdiv. Dinner and overnight stay.

Day 4: Plovdiv – Kazanlak – Veliko Tarnovo (200 km)

After breakfast - set for Kazanlak - the capital of the Valley of roses. Lunch. A visit to the Thracian tomb a remarkable monument from the early Hellenic period, discovered in 1944, under the protection of UNESCO. Accommodation in Veliko Tarnovo. Dinner. Overnight stay.

Day 5: Veliko Tarnovo – Arbanasi – Ivanovo – Veliko Tarnovo (200 km)

Breakfast, Visit to Arbanasi – the Konstantsaliev's museum – house, built in the beginning of the 18th century, Set off for Ivanovo, where you can visit the rock monastery (under the protection of UNESCO). It represents a number of small rock - cut churches, chapels and monks cells, with beautiful frescoes. Get back to Veliko Tarnovo. Dinner and overnight stay.

Day 6: Veliko Tarnovo – Troyan – Sofia (260 km)

After breakfast - set out for Troyan. Arrival and sightseeing tour of the Troyan monastery, built in the 14th century at the end of the Second Bulgarian kingdom. Lunch. Set out for Sofia. Accommodation. Dinner and overnight stay.

Day 7: Sofia – Rila monastery – Sofia (240 km)

Breakfast. Set off for Rila monastery, and doubtlessly the biggest tourist attraction among the monasteries in Bulgaria. It was added to the list of monuments under the protection of UNESCO. Lunch. Get back to Sofia. A visit to the Boyana church - a monument under the protection of UNESCO, situated at the foots of the Vitosha mountain. Dinner. Overnight stay.

Day 8: Sofia

After breakfast, a walk in the centre of the capital, a visit to "St. George" church, the Presidency, the "Narodno Sabranie" square with the Bulgarian Parlament building, the "Aleksandar Nevski" cathedral, the "St. Sofia" church. Lunch. Transfer to the Sofia airport.

The "Ancient Nessebar" museum will help you feel and get acquainted with the ancient town. Its specialists will take you around the spacious halls of the museum; they will do a panoramic tour of the town and will make you acquainted with its monuments and rich history.

The Ancient Nessebar" museum offers to the guests of the town four museum exhibitions: In the Archaeological museum the exhibition "Nessebar during the centuries" is arranged, which represents the rich material and spiritual culture of the town from the first millenium BC till the late Middle Ages. The "St. Stephen" church - the so called "New Metropolitan church" is a remarkable architectural monument from the Middle Ages (built in the X century and reconstructed in XV and XVIII centuries) and one of the rare monuments in our country with well preserved wall paintings from XVI - XVIII centuries. Over 1000 figures in 258 compositions have been depicted.

The "St. Spas" church (1609) with its well preserved and restored wall-paintings from the XVII century is a bright representative of the artistic studios functioning at that time in Nessebar. The Ethnographical museum is arranged in the house of Panayot Muskoyani. It was built in 1840 and represents the Black Sea type of houses from the Bulgarian Revival period.

the route of bulgarian wine

Bulgaria is a country with traditional vine-growing. Here the wine route has been traced for centuries and the journey gives a clear idea of the traditional **Bulgarian wine sorts, extremely interesting** for professionals and connoisseurs of wine.

Day I: Welcoming in Sofia. Accommodation. Breakfast. Drive to Melnik. Visit a renowned wine cellar to taste typical Melnik wines. Dinner. Overnight stay.

Day 2: After breakfast visit the Rozhen monastery. Drive to Plovdiv. Lunch. Explore the Old Town . Dinner. Overnight stay in Plovdiv.

Day 3: Breakfast. Drive to the village of Brestovitsa. Accommodation. Wine-tasting. Dinner in the "Todoroff" wine cellar. Overnight stay at "Todoroff Wine and Spa" hotel.

Day 4: Breakfast. Drive to Sliven. Visit the "Sinite Kamani" /"The Blue Rocks" wine cellar. Enjoy wine-tasting in the "House of Wine". Dinner. Overnight stay.

Day 5: After breakfast your journey continues to Nessebar – one of the most picturesque towns on the Bulgarian Black Sea coast. Visit the "Ancient Nessebar" museum. Lunch. Drive to Varna. Dinner. Overnight stay.

Day 6: Breakfast. Varna sightseeing: the Cathedral, the Archaeological museum, the Roman thermae. Lunch. Free time. Dinner. Overnight stay in the town of Varna.

Day 7: Breakfast. Your tour continues with a visit to the "St. St. Helena and Constantine" monastery – the only one in Bulgaria, under the altar of which one can find "Ayazmoto" (a spring, declared sacred). The relics of St. Valentine are to be found in the museum. Enjoy wine-tasting in "Estreya" wine-cellar. Have a tour of "Golden Sands" and "Albena" resorts; then visit the palace of the Romanian queen in Balchik. Overnight stay.

Day 8: First variant: Breakfast. Drive to Osmar village – the village of wormwood wine and herbal wines. Osmar is one of the four most energetic spots in Bulgaria. Wine-tasting. Drive to Shumen. Dinner. Overnight stay in Shumen. Second variant: After breakfast travel to Belogradets. Gather the grape harvest in a vine massif and enjoy winetasting. Explore the ancient fortress of Ovech. Dinner. Overnight stay in Shumen.

Day 9: Breakfast. Drive to Veliko Tarnovo. Accommodation. Visit Tsarevets. Walk along "Samovodska charshiya" street. Lunch. Visit the "Lyaskovets" wine cellar. Dinner in a restaurant. Overnight stay.

Day 10: Breakfast. Drive to Sofia.



valley of the thracian rulers

Numerous and most interesting Thracian tombs from VI - II century BC are concentrated in the Kazanlak valley, the temples having been used for burials of the Thracian kings.



days

Day I: Welcoming in Sofia. Drive to Kazanlak for an overnight stay.

Day 2: After breakfast, visit the Kazanlak Thracian tomb, included in the World Cultural Heritage list of UNESCO. Visit the Historical – Ethnographical museum, the Art Gallery and the Museum of Rose. Lunch. Spend the afternoon at leisure. Dinner. Overnight stay in Kazanlak.

Day 3: Breakfast. Enjoy a visit to the tombs from IV – III c. B.C., where unique finds of world importance have been discovered - a gold mask from the V century B.C., having no analogue in the world; a bronze head with the face of a Thracian king; the biggest Thracian tomb with its unique gold treasure - the gold wreath, the only gold vessel for drinking wine from the Thracian times and many other objects. Dinner. Overnight stay in Kazanlak.

Day 4: After breakfast travel to the village of Koprinka – there, in the dam close to the village and under the water now, was situated once the Thracian town of Sevtopolis - the capital of Sevt III from the end of the IV c. B.C. Have lunch in a fish restaurant. Visit the "Nativity" temple monument near the town of Shipka, erected in memory of the Russian soldiers, perished in war. Spend the afternoon at leisure. Overnight stay in Kazanlak.

Day 5: Breakfast. Drive to Kardzali and visit Starosel – a Thracian king's complex with a mausoleum - the biggest discovered so far. Lunch. Visit a winery for wine-tasting. Dinner and overnight stay in Kardzali.

Day 6: After breakfast drive to Perperikon and explore this archaeological complex, consisting of a big sanctuary, a sacred town and a fortress. Lunch. Visit Tatul - an ancient pagan sanctuary and mediaeval fortress. Free time. Drive to Sofia. Lunch. City sightseeing. Dinner. Overnight stay in Sofia.

Day 7: Breakfast. Transfer to Sofia airport.



The first historical information about the "Koukeri" ritual dates back to VI c. BC. The "Koukeri" ritual is a pre-spring fest with "masked participants". It's held at the end of February on the first Sunday before Lent, "Clean Monday" or "Dogs'Monday".

They visit every house in their village where they jump up and down, making an incredible noise from their bells while the residents of each house give them food. Lunch. Free time. Dinner.
